

INFORMATION ON FINGERPRINT CARDS AND FINGERPRINTING SERVICES

Arizona Revised Statute § 32-2304 (B)(2) – The Commission May: Require a person who seeks a license pursuant to this chapter to submit to the commission a full set of fingerprints and the fees required by section 41-1750. The commission shall submit the fingerprints and fees to the department of public safety for the purpose of obtaining a state and federal criminal records check pursuant to section 41-1750 and Public Law 92-544. The department of public safety may exchange this fingerprint data with the federal bureau of investigation.

Fingerprint Cards: Only use the blue-outlined, matte finish fingerprint card provided by the SPCC. All spaces must be completed in **BLACK INK ONLY**. Be sure the information is within the allotted space and not over the line. You must clearly print all information on the card except for the signature. **Do not** place any information in the boxes labeled **Employer & Address** and **Reason Fingerprinted**. Fingerprints which are smeared, too dark, too light, or are generally illegible and which cannot be read or processed by the FBI will be rejected and returned, and you will be required to submit another set of fingerprints. **Do not bend or fold the fingerprint card in any way. If the card has been folded or bent, it will be rejected.** Also, do not use a highlighter pen anywhere on the card, as the FBI will reject all cards that contain highlighter markings. We recommend you review your fingerprints before sealing the fingerprint card in the envelope provided. Refer to the reverse side of the fingerprint card, which outlines FBI standards of readable prints.

Fingerprinting Services: The following is a partial list of organizations, firms and individuals who offer fingerprinting services. **The Arizona Structural Pest Control Commission does not regulate fingerprinting services and does not attest to the quality of services provided.** We **strongly** suggest that you contact the fingerprints organization, firm, or individual to inquire about the cost, business hours, restrictions, and information or documents you may be required to bring with you. You may be required to take a photograph for purposes of confirming identity. You may be required to make an appointment.
